2. **IMPORTANT. You must register with the VA to determine eligibility of benefits.**
3. Go to the website <http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/apply.asp>
4. Click on "Apply Online today". This will take you to VONAPP (Veterans Online Application)

If it is your first time using VONAPP select "I am a first time VONAPP user".
